

US FIELD RESEARCH FINDINGS

November 2005 Survey

OVERALL: 68.42% Success Rate

- **Wells: 54.5% success rate**
 - 33 out of 209 surveyed were Wells guests: 15 using, 18 sober
- **Hagaman: 71% success rate**
 - 176 out of 209 surveyed were Hagaman guests: 51 using, 125 sober
- **CE: 68% success rate**
 - 25 out of 209 surveyed had completed 3 months of CE: 8 using, 17 sober (**68% success rate**)
 - 14 out of 209 surveyed did not finish CE: 5 using, 9 sober (**64.3% success rate**)
 - 8 out of 209 surveyed were asked to leave CE: 5 using, 3 sober (**37.5% success rate**)
 - 61.7% overall success rate for all CE attendees
- **RH results without CE guests: 70.4% success rate**
 - 114 sober out of 162 total guests without any CE attendance
- **Results by year attended:**
 - 2005 graduates = **62%** success rate (78 people)
 - 2004 graduates = **63%** success rate (54 people)
 - 2003 graduates = **76%** success rate (38 people)
 - 2002 graduates = **65%** success rate (20 people)
 - 1994-2001 graduates = **100%** success rate (19 people)
- **Results by gender:**
 - **Men: 66.2%** success rate (145 men surveyed)
 - **Women: 73.4%** success rate (64 women surveyed)
- **Employee Count:**
 - 10 out of 209 were employed with BRI at the time of the survey (all sober)
 - accounts for 4.8%
 - stats w/o employees = 133 sober out of 199 = 66.8%
- **Recidivism:**

7% out those surveyed (15 out of 209) had been through the program previously, 66% of those reported "sober" (10 out of 15).
- **Guest vs. Corroborator Reporting:**

Based solely on corroborator-reporting: 71.8% sober
Based solely on guest-reporting: 76.1% sober
